The Cranston Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) is looking for individuals 55 years of age and older to serve as ***“Healthy Futures Consultants”***. Under Healthy Futures, trained senior volunteers will conduct **“How to Prevent Falls at Home”** program. The program consists of 8 one (1) hour sessions for groups of 10 to 12 participants. The program is designed to reduce the fear of falling and increase the activity levels of older adults who have this concern.

All Healthy Futures workshops will be coordinated with the Cranston Department of Senior Services’ RSVP Office.
